Opening Times:

The Team:

Our team is made up of both clinical and non-clinical staff who all work together to encourage wellbeing in our patients by providing the highest standard of health care.

The Doctors:

The Doctor team is made up of Partners and Salaried GPs.

The Nurses:

Our multi-skilled nursing team work across all three sites to provide a range of services to our patients. When you ask for an appointment our receptionists will ask you for some brief details, we are not being nosey, it is just so that we can ensure that you see the person with the right skills and experience as soon as possible.

The Paramedics

Our team of paramedics work alongside our GPs and Nurses to provide an Urgent Care Service, go on home visits to housebound patients and support the GP team in looking after residents in Care Homes

First Contact Physiotherapists

Our team of physios provide both telephone and face to face appointments for patients who are experiencing new onset of musculoskeletal pain. It is not suitable to see our physiotherapists if your pain is ongoing.

The Clinical Support Team

This team includes Social Prescribers who can support patients with a variety of non-medical issues, we have a Health and Well Being Coach who can help you to lose weight and support you in becoming more active. Our Pharmacy team help the doctors in ensuring that any changes to medication that the hospital makes is reflected on the patient GP records.

The Support Team

We have a Site Manager and a team of receptionists/administrators who are here to help you.

Westongrove Recall:

The team are based at Aston Clinton Surgery and manage the health-check programme for all of our patients who have long-term conditions such as Asthma, Diabetes and Heart Disease.
